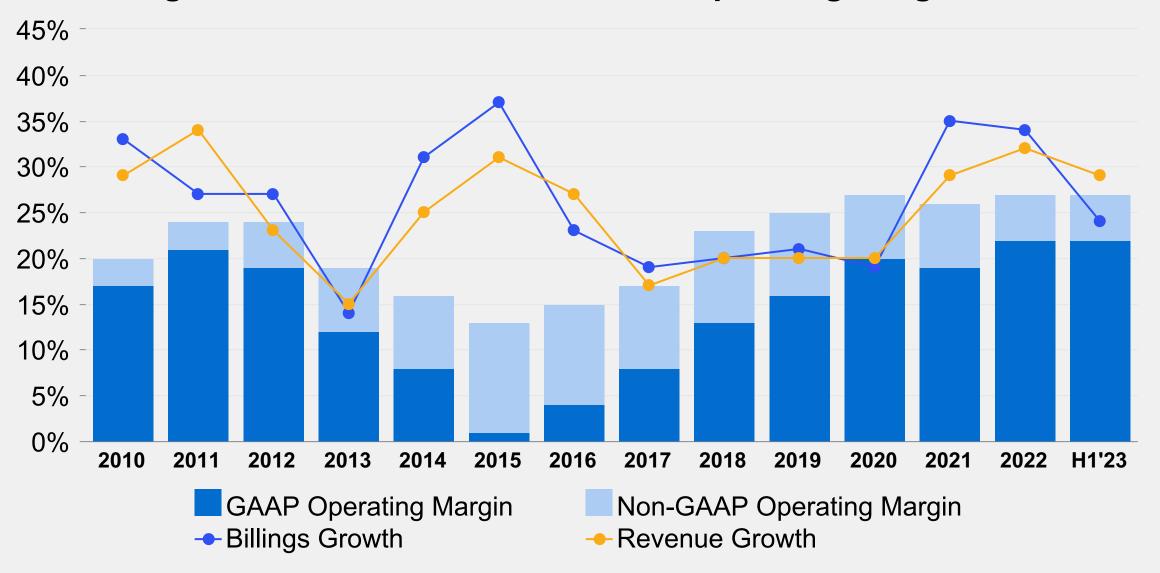
LTM Adjusted Free Cash Flow
